9. How many times does the female octopus mate in its entire lifetime?

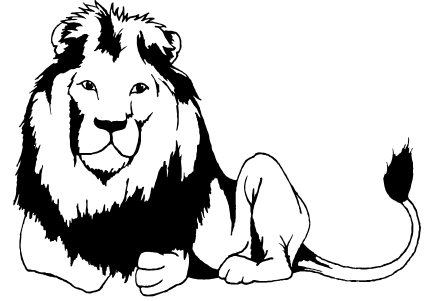


10. What percentage of the Earth is fresh water?
