**\$100,000 AND UNDER**

**Individual Animals - Rhinos (per animal) \$100,000**

An extraordinary opportunity – name a white rhino from Africa.

**Giraffe Great Room - \$100,000**

Ten times the size of the giraffes' existing stalls, this area will allow several giraffes to cavort and play inside the building, to the delight of on-looking visitors.

**Rockwork Archway - \$100,000**

Begin your mystical journey through the forest with this authentic rockwork archway. The archway is a beautiful entrance to the African Forest.

**Trails and Walkways - Chimp, Giraffe (each) \$50,000**

Picturesque trails and walkways such as blinds, overlooks, and viewing platforms. African inspired graphic interpretation, such as posters, murals, and carvings.

**The Outpost - \$50,000**

A themed refreshment facility with posters promoting ecotourism, conservation messages, African wildlife refuges, and more.

**Communications Hut & Conservation Kiosk - \$50,000**

Visitors will use the kiosk to view and listen in on simulated conversations between animals in Africa.

**Rustic Outdoor Shower - \$50,000**

The Pygmy Village will include a rustic outdoor shower in the form of this rustic outdoor shower. Guests will refresh their journey with a gentle dowsing. Consider, in particular, what to do this.

**Education Room in Chimp Building - \$50,000**

This room in the chimpanzee holding area will be a community space for the chimps, where they will engage in behavioral and enrichment activities with their keepers.

**Giraffe Bedrooms (each) - \$50,000**

The giraffe barn will have an elevated walkway that will allow guests to see the giraffes eye-to-eye.

**Gorilla Tommy's Outlook - \$50,000**

A private area specially designed to allow staff to conduct observational research on the chimps from a secluded vantage point.

**Rhino Wallow \$50,000**

Zoo guests will delight as the white rhinos revel in their new wallow, demonstrating instinctive behavior as they would in the wild, such as playing, drinking, and taking baths to cool and condition their skin.

**Rhino Shelter - \$50,000**

This rhino shelter will blend seamlessly into the landscape and will allow for flexibility in moving and holding the animals. It will also provide access for veterinary staff to safely and easily perform medical procedures when necessary.

**Chimp Bedrooms and Common Area (7) - \$25,000**

Here the chimps tuck themselves in for a good night's sleep. These areas are not accessible to the public, but will be seen by VIP visitors on behind-the-scenes tours.

**African Musical Instruments and Artifacts - \$25,000**

Authentic replicas of African musical instruments and artifacts as part of an exhibit that children can touch and handle, allowing them to have a hands-on experience.

**Tree House Specimen Cabinets - \$25,000**

A collection of scientific specimens and artwork will be on display in acrylic cabinets for further investigation.

**Chimp Urgent Care and Treatment Room - \$25,000**

Inside the chimp house is a special room where the Zoo's veterinarians can easily perform medical procedures and examinations without having to take the chimps to a separate facility.

**Benches (5 in high-traffic locations) (each) - \$25,000**

**Benches (10 in other locations) (each) - \$15,000 - 8 left!**

Rustic benches located along shaded pathways and by exhibits will offer guests a chance to rest before continuing their Forest journey.
